The general membership of the TSA-H RAC is to be made up of individuals and/or organizations that provide trauma care, or are interested in the provision of trauma care. Those may include individuals representing trauma facility hospitals, EMS provider organizations, First Responder Organizations, health care educational institutions, public safety agencies, physicians, nurses, and/or other organizations interested in trauma care. The General Assembly is made up of participant members present at General Assembly meetings. Voting members of the General Assembly are those individuals designated by their respective entity to vote for, and on behalf of, the entity. General Assembly members are expected to attend and participate in the General Assembly meetings and to serve and participate on standing committee meetings and activities.

In accordance with the DETRAC Bylaws, the Executive Committee will conduct the business of the RAC. The Executive Committee consists of one representative appointed by each hospital in the TSA-H region, one representative appointed by each EMS provider in the TSA-H region, one representative from each post-secondary college or university in the TSA-H region that is providing EMS education, one First Responder from each county and one physician appointed by each hospital in the TSA-H region, in the event of a county without a hospital, a physician will be appointed by the County Judge.
